

## Important Updates as of March 8<sup>th</sup>:

- ❖ The Jamboree is FULL for camping with 8,000 Scouts, Scouters and Families. From now until 6 pm on April 9<sup>th</sup>, you can sign up on the internet for advance purchase day passes for \$15 per person which includes a day's admission, the NorCal Jamboree patch, lunch and a souvenir book. At the event, the entrance fee will be \$20 and will include the NorCal Jamboree patch and a souvenir book.
  
- ❖ Other places you might find camping would be through the East Bay Regional Parks Campground reservation line at 1-888-327-2757 option #2 for Del Valle Campground in Livermore Hills and Anthony Chabot Campgrounds in the Castro Valley area.
