

## SCCC NORCAL JAMBOREE GUIDELINES

- **No** open fires are permitted at the fairgrounds. **Not** even for cooking!
- **No** pets, **No** bikes.
- **No** digging of holes.
  
- Each unit should have a First Aid kit, training on basic first aid, and a Guide To Safe Scouting which has been read by the leaders.
- Read the Leaders Guide from NorCal on their website.
- Our subcamp will have a SCCC Administration Booth with additional very basic first aid supplies and will be available for assistance and information.

- All injuries must be reported to unit leaders and the Jamboree First Aid stations.
- PROCEDURE FOR SERIOUS INJURY:
  1. Pleasanton Police Department:           1-925-931-5100
  2. Have a second leader call the Jamboree emergency phone number and direct emergency vehicles:           1-209-484-5925
  3. Have the Scout's buddy contact the unit leader for medical information and parent phone numbers
- EMERGENCY such as Earthquake

Your assembly area is your assigned campsite. Do a headcount and report by runner to the SCCC Admin. Booth. Try to keep phone lines open.
- BSA Youth Protection and two-deep leadership must be followed.
- Please enforce the Buddy System.
- It is expected that all youth participants will remain in the fairgrounds throughout the Jamboree. The Council Subcamp Chief **MUST** be notified whenever a youth participant leaves the fairgrounds for any reason.
- Respect other sites by using the walkways established. No shortcuts.
- Quiet time is in effect from 10:00 PM to 06:00 AM.
- Keep all paved roadways within the fairgrounds open for emergency vehicles.
- Water will be at a premium. Do NOT wash dishes at the water wagon. Carry water back to your site to do your cleaning.
- Pack it in, pack it out. Bring plenty of trash bags.
- Cooking area must be 20 feet from all tents with no canopy allowed. Permitted cooking is by BSA approved gas or charcoal stoves. Only raised grills may be used with charcoal.  
(It is suggested to use a combined patrol cooking area in one corner of your site that is adjacent to three other sites.)
  
- Remember, we are all Scouts and we are guests at the fairgrounds. Please be respectful of their property. Help one another to have fun and be safe.
